Bangkok is under a curfew right now. Our kids are home because all Bangkok schools have been closed. Some of our children's friends have left the country because travel within the city is too dangerous. The death toll is 52. It is hard to believe that the central area of BKK has been destroyed by arson. Even the huge Central World mall has been burnt to the ground. We are shocked and saddened over the senseless loss of life.

But while Bangkok is burning, Jesus' power to rescue

Thai and Burm*se people from this dominion of darkness, one soul at a time, is simply undeniable!

This past Tuesday, 11 Burm*se people prayed to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior at our Burm*se worship service. During the day, we went out into the streets with our break-dancing friend, Bank and invited people to come to church. One man was so excited to meet Bank and finally learn how to break-dance, that he took the day off work and came to church. He heard the Good News of God's love for him and gave his life to Christ.



That same day, we shared the Gospel with some poor children living in a local Ice Factory. **While we were teaching, I noticed a 9 year-old boy named, Nat who looked especially dirty and neglected.** I asked him, gently, why he wasn't in school. He said that he didn't like school and wasn't interested. He also told me that his mom had left him a long time ago. Just at that moment, Nat's father pulled up on his motorcycle. He was drunk. After listening to lots of excuses I asked the Dad if he would promise to help his son get to school if I bought him a uniform. He agreed. So before Nat had a chance to protest too much, I hustled him off to the market and got him suited up for school. I had a restless night praying and asking God to rescue this little boy from a life of poverty and rejection. The next day I went off to the school to take a peek in the classroom to see if my new little friend had made it to school. When I poked my head around the corner into the

classroom, I was pleased to see Nat sitting at his desk smiling, with a new haircut and a clean uniform on.

To my surprise the teacher came out to see me. When I told her about Nat's family, I was shocked to see her suddenly burst into tears! I knew right away that the love of Jesus was touching the heart of this teacher who worked in the Buddhist Temple School. Even though she was a complete stranger, I embraced her in a big hug and started praying for her. I thanked God for this teacher's heart of mercy and blessed her work at the school. **I walked away from the Temple praising God for his tender love for little boys.**
